
INTERCHANGE STEWARD



Ensures the interchange of players during a match adheres to the rules of the game



KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

- Ensure the correct number of players are on the field at the beginning of each quarter
- Ensure players only leave the interchange holding area upon another leaving the field
- Record incidents relating to both the game and interchange area

KEY RELATIONSHIPS

- All match umpires and team managers (home and opposition)
- Match Day Manager (game day) and Club Volunteer Coordinator for questions surrounding the role, changes in availability etc.

WHAT NOT TO DO

 Forget to do a headcount. Particularly in a grand final.
