



COACH OF THE YEAR AWARD

CRITERIA

AWARD GUIDELINES:

This award recognises the exceptional contribution by people within our community who enrich the lives of others through providing the opportunity to participate. The Club Coach of the Year Award is presented to a Coaching Team Member (including Coach or Assistant Coach) who has shown outstanding commitment, service, innovation and/or achievements in developing and preparing players for the season, within any team of the Mt Gravatt Vultures JAFc.

Award Criteria Consideration:

1. Coaching achievement during the current Football season.
2. Completion of recognised Coaching Accreditation Course/s.
3. Inspired young players and encouraged greater participation, promoting fair play and making the game more welcoming and inclusive
4. Instilled positive values in their players.
5. Applied appropriate, accepted training theory and coaching principles to improve the level of performance of the team
6. Presents a positive image of coaching and is a role model to players and the community.
7. Shows respect for players, officials, opponents & supporters within our football community - club and AFLQ.
8. Has adhered to relevant club and AFLQ policies and procedures, including the Code of Conduct.
9. Displays the values and attributes the club espouses to.

Nomination and Selection Process:

Coach of the Year nominees must be nominated by someone other than themselves. Written nominations are invited by all registered club members and are to be provided to the Secretary no later than the 1st August each year.

All nominations regardless of coaching accreditation level, with input from the Club's Coaching Coordinator, will be considered by the Club Committee (Selection Committee). The Coach of the Year Award will be determined by a majority ballot of the Selection Committee.

*Note: an award may not necessarily be granted each year. This may be because there are no nominations received, or the Selection Committee may deem that the nomination/s do not meet the criteria.

Consideration should be given to:

- Is the nominee selfless in assisting others to achieve?
- What sets the nominee apart from others?
- How does the nominee positively contribute to their sport, club, team or association?
- Does the nominee's contribution go largely unrewarded or unrecognised?

Has the coach been a role model & positive influence on others in the broader community, if so, how?

Consideration should be given to:

- Has the nominee inspired others and supported others to achieve their goals?
- Has the nominee led by example and demonstrated their leadership skills?
- How does the nominee set an example and positively influence others?
