

## Youth Coach

### Your Role

You will be responsible for the provision of up-to-date training and ensure all players in the age squad are provided an opportunity to improve their football skills

### Objectives

- To provide the highest standard of coaching and development to the players of the appointed age of competition

### Responsibilities

- Ensure players understand their obligations to the sport and know the rules of play
- Understand the codes of behaviour for yourself, players, parents and team management personnel
- Know the policies, complaint processes and guidelines under the Child Protection Risk Management Program and how they apply
- Ensure a training plan which provides the player with variety and challenges has been developed
- Apply the code of conduct for coaching staff and players which supports the objectives of the Club on and off the field
- Instruct players placed under your care generally and see all players carry out sufficient training
- Liaise with other club coaches to establish a consistent coaching policy throughout the club

### Desirable attributes

- Well-developed communication skills especially as an effective listener
- Good questioning skills
- Empathy
- Well organised
- Passion for assisting players to improve
- Enthusiastic positive encourager
